Following the theme of bad weather, we do like to get outside as much as possible so please send your children in with suitable clothing and footwear especially during play schemes.



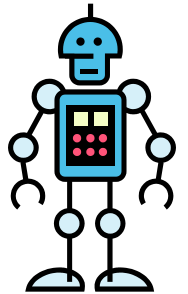
